MCLS FY2017 Audit Report Highlights

- Conducted by Maner Costerisan, Certified Public Accountants
- Another clean audit, with an "unmodified" opinion. Thank you, MCLS staff!
- Change in net assets: +\$247,059 in 2017 compared to 2016
 - More activity in group licensing
 - Administrative contract fees are up (MI-ALA and Library of Michigan)
 - Investment income is up


