- Review and pay invoices through the MCLS Portal

What is eLicensing & Collection Resources (eLCR)?

Through an annual membership fee, members access MCLS eLCR program, which saves time and money through subscription management, consolidated and customized invoicing, and discounts on products from databases to library supplies.

What is Consortia Manager and the MCLS Portal and what are they for?

Consortia Manger (CM) is software MCLS and members use to manage member subscriptions. Members designate who can access CM to renew, request pricing, or view and manage subscriptions.
